We will be teaching how to forge roses and leaves and will cover different assembly methods (including welding and no-weld methods) as well as finishing processes. **The workshop will be free to attend.**

The event will be Saturday, Jan 26th, 2019 at Cliff Bohm's workshop (4360 Curtice Rd, Mason, MI, 48854) from 10 AM till 4 PM.

You will have the option to hand cut your own blanks (free!) or use pre-cut blanks that we will purchased in advance.

**Pre-cut blanks can per purchased for \$7.49 each. If you would like to forge your rose(s) from a pre-cut blank, let us know by sending an order for blanks to [info.blacksmiths@gmail.com](mailto:info.blacksmiths@gmail.com) so we know how many you would like to purchase.**

Payment for blanks can be made by check or cash on the day of the event.

**Please let us know if you are planning to attend.** You should bring your own hammer (cross peen if you have it!) and tongs (but don't worry we will have loaner equipment). You must wear non-flammable (e.g. cotton, leather, etc. - NOT SYNTHETIC!) clothes and footwear. We will have eye protection that you can borrow, but if you have your own, please bring that.

We would appreciate if some folks would bring anvils and forges. We would also appreciate it if anyone can bring tin snips, metal shears or a Beverly shear. Please let [info.blacksmiths@mail.com](mailto:info.blacksmiths@mail.com) know if you are able and planning to bring any of this equipment.

The main dish for lunch will be provided, and participants are encouraged to bring sides, desserts, and drinks.
