Tool Loan Program for MABA members

You are interested in blacksmithing and you have joined MABA. If you want to try smithing before you acquire your own tools, you may apply for the MABA tool loan program.

A basic tool set may be signed out for a three (3) month period and can be renewed upon review by the MABA officers.

A complete inventory list and photo of the tools are made when the tool set is loaned out. The \$100 security deposit is refunded, upon return of the tool set in good repair.

The member who signs out the tool set will be responsible for:

- Arranging to pick up tools from storage, and getting it to their site.
- Arranging the return of tools at the end of the loan.
- Adding a tool or enhancing the tool set during their loan.

LIABILITY RELEASE FORM
